### Sample Trip Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrive in Staniel Cay and meet your guides. You can get you checked into your hotel so you can begin relaxing and enjoying the beautiful settlement of Staniel Cay. We will meet for dinner that night at the yacht club and discuss the next few days and what everybody's expectations are for the trip.

Day 2: We load up our equipment in the support boat and tow the boats about 7 miles NW to Compass Cay where we will leave the boat and pack our kayaks. From Compass we will paddle across Conch Cut into the Land and Sea Park where we will land on Cambridge Cay. Once there we will set up camp, snorkel and relax.

Day 3: After breakfast we will pack up camp and continue heading north to arrive at Osprey Cay. This breathtaking cay features beautiful sand dunes on the south side and a cool cave and an Osprey that nests on the northern side.

Day 5: Time to pack up and start heading back SE. We'll head to O'Briens Cay. The incredible Sea Aquarium is also located near O'Briens Cay and will be a must-see for this leg of the trip.

Day 6: After a hearty breakfast we will pack up camp, once again, and head to Compass Cay where we will reload the support boat and drive back to Staniel Cay for some lunch, hot shower and a cozy bed! Oh yeah, and did I forget to mention swim with the nurse sharks too 😊
